

Fast Track Vocational Nursing Program Admission Guidelines Program Starts: August 2024 and Graduate in Summer 2025

I. Program Admission and Selection Criteria

- A. Admission Criteria
 - Complete all prerequisite requirements: Work-In-Progress courses are accepted.
 - a. English 100 Reading and Composition
 - b. Math College Level Math
 - c. NSC 128 Medical Terminology
 - d. NUR 102 Intro to Anatomy and Physiology -or-
 - BIO 210 Human Anatomy and BIO 211 Human Physiology
 - e. PSY 201 Human Growth and Development (Lifespan)
 - High School official transcript, or GED, or equivalency
 - ATI/TEAS Assessment (50% or higher)
- B. Selection Criteria

Students who meet the admission criteria are given a composite score based on the following criteria:

- 1. GPA in prerequisite subjects (min. 3.0)
- 2. Overall GPA (min. 3.0)
- 3. ATI/TEAS Admission Exam (50% or higher)
- 4. Work experience in the healthcare-related field
- 6. Certification/License in healthcare related field

II. Timeline

All candidates meeting the Admission and Selection criteria will be ranked and admitted. There will be up to 15 students selected.

- A. Candidate Pool
 - 1. Deadline for all application materials: May 31, 2024.
 - 2. Notification of Status: By June 7, 2024.
