International Students

Reference: Education Code Sections 76141, 76142; Title 5 Section 54045; Title 8, U.S.C. Section 1101 et seq.

Applicants shall meet the following criteria for admission to Palo Verde College:

- 1. Return a typed or printed application form to Palo Verde College;
- 2. Submit transcripts from secondary or higher institutions attended;
- 3. Submit the results of a physical examination, including a California tuberculin clearance examination completed within the last six (6) months.
- 4. Submit the results of the TOEFL examination (minimum score of 450) or arrange to come to Palo Verde College for a personal interview to demonstrate sufficient command of the English language to profit from instruction.
- 5. Submit a statement from a bank or other financial institution that the student has a least \$5,000 per year available for study in the United States.
- 6. Provide proof of medical coverage or be prepared to purchase medical insurance.
- 7. Possess a student visa (not a visitor's visa). Resident determination, including review of whether students holds a visa that requires them to have a residence outside of the U.S., or entered the U.S. under a visa that permits entry solely for a temporary purpose.

Students who will be attending pursuant to an F-1 visa must submit paperwork to verify that form I-20 (SEVIS) has been issues to the District. See also BP/AP 5015 - Residence Determination.

For exemptions from nonresident tuition, see BP/AP 5020 - Nonresident Tuition.

The District may establish additional rules and regulations for the admission of international students on a selective basis.
