Public Presentation of Initial Collective Bargaining Proposals

Reference: Government Code Section 3547

The Superintendent/President is directed to enact administrative procedures that assure compliance with the requirements of Government Code Section 3547 regarding the presentation to the Board of initial proposals for collective bargaining.

Collective bargaining begins when either an exclusive representative or the District itself presents an initial proposal for consideration in accordance with the following timelines:

- Meeting and negotiating between district and employee organization representatives shall not take place on initial proposals until a reasonable time has elapsed after the submission of such proposals in order to enable the public to become informed and to express itself regarding the proposals at a public Board meeting.
- 2. After the public has had an opportunity to provide input, the Board shall adopt its initial proposal at a public meeting. Thereafter, meeting and negotiating with respect to the proposal may take place.
- 3. New subjects of meeting and negotiating arising after the presentation of initial proposals shall be made public within 24 hours. If a vote is taken on any such subject by the Board, each Board member's vote also shall be made public within 24 hours.
