

Sexual and Other Assaults on Campus

Reference: Education Code Section 67385; Jeanne Clery Disclosure of Campus Security Policy and Campus Criminal Statistics Act; 34 C.F.R. § 668.46(b)(11)

Any sexual assault or physical abuse, including, but not limited to, rape, as defined by California law, whether committed by an employee, student, or member of the public that occurs on District property, is a violation of District policies and procedures, and is subject to all applicable punishment, including criminal procedures and employee or student discipline procedures. Students, faculty, and staff who may be victims of sexual and other assaults shall be treated with dignity and provided comprehensive assistance. The Superintendent/President shall establish administrative procedures that ensure students, faculty, and staff who are victims of sexual and other assaults receive appropriate information and treatment. The procedures for sexual assaults shall meet the criteria contained in Education Code Section 67385 and 34 C.F.R. § 668.46.
