










Palo Verde College CDCR FTES 2019-20 to 2023-24

Palo Verde College Fire Science Enrollment 2019-20 to 2023-24*




Palo Verde College Fire Science FTES 2019-20 to 2023-24*





<u>Special Admits Enrollment</u> 2019-20 to 2023-24




Palo Verde College Special Admits FTES 2019-20 to 2023-24

Face to Face Enrollment 2019-20 to 2023-24*




Palo Verde College Face to Face FTES 2019-20 to 2023-24*








Palo Verde College Online FTES 2019-20 to 2023-24

 guides all planning and budget allocation, and consideration of a 3-to 4-year Strategic Plan to operationalize the Educational Master Plan
 (Accreditation and Chancellor's Office Requirement)
- Need to expand Dual Enrollment (CCAP and Non CCAP), Online, and Adult Education programs
- Expand services to our local community
- Emphasis on fiscal stability Next three fiscal years could be troublesome based on State fiscal condition. Reserves are strong; strategic investments in educational programs and outward facing community services needed.
