

Vocational Nursing Program Admission Guidelines

Program Starts: August 2023 and Graduate in Summer 2024

I. Program Admission and Selection Criteria

A. Admission Criteria

Complete all prerequisite requirements: Work-In-Progress courses are accepted.

- a. NUR 100 (CNA Theory), NUR 118 (CNA Clinical)
- b. NSC 128 (Medical Terminology)
- c. NUR 102 (Intro to Anatomy and Physiology)

-or

BIO 210 (Human Anatomy) and BIO 211 (Human Physiology)

- d. PSY 201 (Lifespan)
- e. Eng. 100 or 101 and Math 95 criteria

High School official transcript - or – GED

Admission Assessment Exam. We will notify applicants when the test is given at PVC, Do NOT take ahead of time.

B. Selection Criteria

Students who meet the admission criteria are given a composite score based on the following criteria:

- 1. GPA in prerequisite subjects (min. 2.5)
- 2. Overall GPA (min. 2.5)
- 3. ATI Admission Exam
- 4. Background clearance must be complete
- 5. Work experience in healthcare-related field
- 6. Certification/License in healthcare related field
- 7. Letters of Reference (3) –Instructor/employer/supervisor/healthcare professional
- 8. Essay on assigned topic Blind scoring (see Essay Guidelines)
- 9. Interview Panel

II. Timeline

All candidates meeting the Admission and Selection criteria will be ranked and admitted. There will be up to 15 students pending BVNPT approval.

 - 2. Notification of Status: On or before August 2023 (TBA).
