TRANSITION – NUR 268 (LVN to ADN)

NUR 268: LVN-ADN Transition will be offered to LVNs who have passed the NCLEX Exam and are ready to transition into our ADN Program at Palo Verde College. This course is an advanced placement (bridge) course for LVNs only. This course will be offered only in the Fall semester as LVNs accepted into the ADN program can transition into the 3rd semester of the program in the Spring semester. The course is 4-units and focuses on the concepts of safe, quality evidence-based care, critical thinking, caring, professionalism, leadership, collaboration/communication, and nursing informatics. The course consists of one and a half hours of lecture per week and an 8-hour day of clinical/lab to prepare LVNs for a successful transition into the ADN program.

*To register for the course, you must see a nursing counselor, have your ADN application complete with a copy of current LVN license and submitted.

*Prerequisites for the ADN program needs to be completed prior to applying for the Associate Degree in Nursing (ADN) program.
