RN Application Checklist

Use this RN application checklist as a guide for successfully completing the application process for the college and the RN program.

Note: All application materials must be received on or before the designated deadline of each year.

The deadline can be located by visiting: Palo Verde College - Registered Nurse (RN) Program

- Step 1: Complete college enrollment by visiting the <u>California Community Colleges</u> website
 - o Be sure to complete college enrollment prior to applying for the RN program!
 - Applicants who fail to do this will not be considered for admission.
 - o A placement test may be required after applying.
- ☐ Step 2: Review RN supportive forms on the PVC website
 - RN Application with Supporting Documents
 - o The point system found in the "Multi-Selection Criteria Form"
 - o Pre-requisite Courses
 - RN Informational Sheet with Estimated Costs
 - Student Handbook (RN) Program
 - o NUR268 Transition
- ☐ Step 3: Complete general education (GE) requirements
 - According to the Multi-Selection Criteria point system students missing Math or Chemistry will have 5 points deducted for each missing course
 - Other GE courses (Psychology, Sociology, Humanities, Speech, or Nutrition) will result in
 2 points deducted for each missing course
- ☐ Step 4: Complete pre-requisite courses
 - o These courses can be located on the PVC website
 - Students must pass these courses with a "C" or higher and a minimum 2.5 GPA in prerequisite science courses
 - Final grades must be recorded, applicants with "in progress" courses will not be reviewed for consideration. The application will be deemed incomplete
- Step 5: After applying to the college send transcripts from other colleges/universities
 - You may skip this step if you've completed all your coursework at PVC
 - Please do this in a timely manner as this may take some time to review transfer courses
 - Are you sending transcripts in with your RN application?

☐ Step 7: Register to take the TEAS test by visiting <u>TEAS Exam Registration (atitesting.com)</u>

- o Must be within 4 years and can be taken multiple times to improve your score
- o Applicants should aim to achieve 62% or higher in all subjects
- o TEAS scores of 62% or higher will be considered for application

☐ Step 8: Apply for the RN program

- o Applications can be submitted online on the PVC website
- Applicants missing documents like the college admission, TEAS exam, courses, or transcripts will not be considered for admission.
