Esteemed Colleagues,

On the morning of November 3, 2010, an e-mail was sent by Dr. Greg Nall that publicly claims the PVC Academic Senate leadership acted in a questionable and suspicious manner. Despite the Senate leadership's public apology and admission to error concerning Resolution 2010-7, it was claimed "this was not an error or mistake. This was an outright manipulation of legislative process and it should be strongly condemned." The Senate leadership has reached a consensus that we have been informally, yet publicly, accused of legislative corruption and fraud. The claim of corruption was also publicly proclaimed at the last Senate meeting of October 26 and is now public record.

Therefore, the Senate leadership asks that if you have evidence of such inappropriate behavior, please formally address the Senate with your charges. If you desire to pursue impeachment and removal of the Senate leadership per your charges, please be advised that there is currently no language in the Senate bylaws for this action. Therefore, the Senate leadership advises that if you pursue your charges against it, please consider the following actions as a recommended procedure:

Action to nullify Senate Resolution 2010-7: Opposition to SLOs in Faculty Evaluations

Formally present a resolution to nullify Resolution 2010-7 as an item of business on the next general meeting agenda. You may request immediate action (vote) or discussion through the proper legislative process. To pass this resolution, you will need a simple majority vote.

Impeachment and Removal of Officers

Having no language in our current bylaws for this action, you will have to wait until the revised bylaws are approved by the senate body. The revisions do include language for removal of officers.
