Resolution Reaffirming the Curriculum Development Process Resolution No. 06-07-04

WHEREAS, the faculty have a central role in curriculum development; and

WHEREAS, the faculty recognize the importance of adhering to established and effective procedures in curriculum development; and

WHEREAS, the faculty recognize that curriculum development requires the coordination of Divisions, Curriculum Committee and Office of Instructional Services; and

WHEREAS, the Curriculum Committee is a committee of the Academic Senate,

THEREFORE, the faculty of the Academic Senate reaffirm the procedure by which curriculum is developed and approved, namely,

- 1. Curriculum shall be presented on the most current forms, including the Course Outline and, where appropriate, Prerequisite/Co-requisite/Advisory Justification, which are available on the Curriculum Committee page of the Palo Verde College Website;
- 2. New curriculum and curriculum changes are initiated by faculty members in the Division in which the curriculum is taught;
- 3. Curriculum is then reviewed and approved by the Division in which curriculum is taught;
- 4. Curriculum is then presented by a Division representative to the Curriculum Committee for consideration at a scheduled meeting of the Curriculum Committee;
- 5. Upon approval by the Curriculum Committee, curriculum is then transmitted by the Curriculum Committee Co-Chair, or representative, to the Office of Instructional Services for presentation to the Board of Trustees;
- 6. Upon approval by the Board of Trustees, curriculum is incorporated into the College Catalog and appropriate College documents.
