## **New Business**

She also spoke on issues related to "pre-requisites" and how that is tied to our accuplacer. She finally also addressed "multiple measures" and how that is also part of a guided process for assessing students.

David spoke on online workshop that helps improve teaching activities. He also stated more information will be passed on to instructors for future training.

David covered an interesting topic that was presented at the "All Staff" meeting that took place a week prior to this senate meeting. In essence, it was on "Curriculum Output and Enrollment Management." We are seeking feedback and thoughts about the entirety of the process and how that helps or not on enrollment management at PVC.

David asked everyone to link into the power-point and then provide feedback by email to the senate President. There was a dialog over having an ideal "schedule of time of classes." Other discussion points were focused on high school enrollments and how that affects enrollment management. Most importantly, there were discussion on the develop to our new state vision, of which is to set our new goals by (1) reducing achievement gaps, (2) increase the number of transfers to 4 year programs, (3) increase the number of CTE completers and lead to finding occupations in the field of study, (4) increase the

number of associate degree graduates, and (5) reduce the number of units to earn an associate's degree. David also had a power point to illustrate the college's success rates and the college's score card overall.
