CONSTITUTION

PREAMBLE

We, the faculty of Palo Verde College, do hereby establish a local organization to represent the faculty in the Palo Verde Community College District in Blythe, California and other campuses within the jurisdiction of the Palo Verde Community College District.

NAME

The official name of this organization shall be the Palo Verde College Academic Senate.

PURPOSE

It shall be the purpose of the Academic Senate to

1. Represent the faculty of Palo Verde College in the formation of local college district policies on academic and professional matters.
2. Make recommendations on local matters affecting the Palo Verde Community College District.
3. Promote and provide the implementation of faculty policies and procedures regarding matters of local concern.
4. Provide unity and support between other organizations within the Palo Verde Community College District.
5. Assume responsibilities and duties as may be delegated by the Academic Senate of California Community Colleges or by the Board of Trustees of Palo Verde Community College District.
6. Initiate policy positions relevant to the Palo Verde Community College District.

POWERS & DUTIES

The power of the Academic Senate derives from California Education Code Title 5 and implements its power through its resolution process.
