RESOLUTION #2009-10:1 DIRECT IMPLEMENTATION OF COURSE PREREQUISITES FOR STUDENT SUCCESS

First Reading: Tuesday, September 22, 2009

1	WHEREAS, unprepared Palo Verde College students are not able to demonstrate
2	proficient skills in comprehension, composition, or quantitative analysis necessary
3	for transfer or collegiate-level courses, yet these students enroll in upper-division
4	courses because of the absence of prerequisites and mandated placement;
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6	WHEREAS, Basic Skills as a Foundation for Student Success in California Community
7	Colleges (2007) summarizes the research confirming that alignment of entry-exit
8	skills and careful organization of instruction is essential to student success;
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10	WHEREAS, the Faculty uses course content development, instruction, assessment,
11	and evaluation to ensure academic integrity and delineate necessary entry skills to
12	promote student success that is equivalent to the student learning outcomes and
13	exit skills of the prerequisite course with the skills and concepts needed in the
14	upper-level courses for transfer, graduation, and degree programs;

16	WHEREAS, the Faculty has been tasked with full implementation of course
17	prerequisites for upper-division transfer and collegiate-level courses, per
18	recommendation of the Academic Senate for California Community Colleges;
19	therefore,
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21	BE IT RESOLVED, collegiate-level courses will have in place the necessary
22	prerequisites to ensure students enter with essential, proficient reading, writing,
23	and computation skills; and
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25	BE IT RESOLVED, the Academic Senate for California Community Colleges remind
26	local Senate bodies to ensure that a prerequisite challenge process must be available
27	to students; and
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29	BE IT RESOLVED, that the Palo Verde College Academic Senate accept and practice
30	the recommendations of the Academic Senate for California Community Colleges
31	"that once new prerequisites are implemented, colleges conduct research on the

32 effect(s) of the prerequisites..."; and

BE IT RESOLVED, that Palo Verde College will begin direct implementation of course

35 prerequisites, for transfer and collegiate-level courses, in the fall semester of 2010

36 and continue so forth, pending continuing research, practice, and evaluation.
