Segment Analysis of Item 069: There is a good variety of courses provided on this campus.

This analysis focuses on selected characteristics of students responding to this item, which is classified as an area of “Challenge” for the College because students perceived it as having high Importance and either low Satisfaction or high Gap. The boxed figures highlight areas of exceptionally large Gap, that is, ≥ 0.90 .

Students seeking associate degrees and transfer, like the 19-24 age segment, indicate large Gaps between Importance and Satisfaction on several Challenge Items.

Needles Center students indicate an especially large Gap on the matter of course variety, followed by Main campus students.
