Significant Findings: It appears as if all the cohorts have experienced a steady % increase over the noted dates. The only dropoff is "foster" and "veteran", two areas with the fewest enrollments hence potential greater volatility. "Inmate" and "Male" numbers experienced greatest individual increases in the final year with only a slight dropoff.

Conclusions and Next Steps: Continue with current rotation of courses. Consider adding additional full time faculty in PSY and HIS to supplement Division needs. Current new faculty in CHD and ANT should help grow those areas. SOC position will be filled this semester.
