Brian Thiebaux brought a recommendation from the Academic Senate to the committee regarding requirements for graduation with an Associate Degree. The area to be changed was from page 54 of the 06-07 catalog. The Senate recommended making changes regarding the requirements for graduation where grades and grade point averages are concerned. A brief discussion took place and the following changes were made:

Second Bullet: A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better in all coursework (as defined by the major).

Third Bullet: A cumulative grade point average of 2.0 or better with no more than three (3) units of "D" in the curriculum upon which the degree is based. A grade of "C" or better in the curriculum upon which the degree is based.

It was moved by Brian Thiebaux and seconded by Dennese Lilley-Edgerton to approve the changes to the "Requirements for graduation with an Associate Degree" section of the catalog effective Fall 2007. All members in favor; motion carried.
